MINUTES

1. **Apologies:** Mrs C Draper and Mr S Harrod (District Councillor)

2. **Declarations of interest:** None.

3. **Approval of previously circulated minutes:**
The minutes were approved and signed.

4. **Matters arising from previous minutes:**

a. Pelican crossing in village – In the absence of Mrs Purse, this item was deferred. To be on agenda for next meeting.

b. Drainage works in village:

Ickford Road – Drainage problems caused by surface water on road not flowing into ditch by allotments.

Sandy Lane – blocked drain causing pooling which County Highways say cannot be cleared until water has subsided.

Draycot – drain blocked under road, so water running on surface.

A418 – water running down road on village side of Albury Lane.

Clerk to report these matters to Geoff Burell of County Highways.

c. Hedges on London Road, Milton Common - Residents have been sent notices requiring them to cut back hedges within 28 days. Vegetation is on highway side of ditch. Clerk to contact County Highways. To be on agenda for next meeting.

d. Clerk to endeavour to ascertain ownership of allotments behind the Fox and also to ask County Council what land they own in the Parish.

Clerk has circulated list of volunteers to Councillors.
